{Jesus Cookies}

Love is the fuel for the KAIROS weekend. One significant element of that love is the cookies—home-baked and prayed-over. They can open the inmates' hearts to God's amazing love. Think how long it may have been since they had a home-baked cookie? They are a token of love to let them know that they are not forgotten. Someone in the world cares about them.

How do I get in on the love?

Bake, cool, and freeze 2-2 1/2" cookies

Package 6 to a quart zip lock (no zipper slides, please)

Use oil or Crisco, but NOT butter

Any kind of cookie, but no icing, sugar, or sprinkles

Nuts o.k. but mark on bag

Yes, they can have raisins in them.

Label type on bag

Chocolate, chocolate chip, peanut butter, snickerdoodles, oatmeal, etc.
are favored. {Even ginger snaps.}

A one-inch scoop will make just the right size

How many do we need?

About 2500 dozen—but you don't have to do them all!! Ask your friends.

When do we need them?

The weekend begins Thursday, Aug. 6, so we should shoot for them to be to the church by Sunday, Aug. 2. But certainly not later than Wednesday, August 5.

Some useful hacks:

Sam's/Walmart has frozen dough.

Slice-and-bake dough may be cut in half to make the right size.

Virtually any cake mix can be used—1 box + 1/2 cup oil + 2 eggs—for variety.
